A prolific writer of poetry and prose, he held a personal Chair in English at Melbourne University and spent most of his professional life at Melbourne University. When living with cancer in his final years, he resided at Newman College. A student of Vincent Buckley, Steele credited Buckley with creating the criticism of Australian literature so that it could become a subject of academic study at tertiary level.
