Founder of the Marist Brothers in Australia

Br Ludovic came to Australia early in 1872 as the leader of a band of four Marist brothers. He opened St Patrick's school in The Rocks on 8 April, 1872, the first Marist brothers' school in Australia.

The early years were challenging, but Ludovic's strength of character and engaging personality saw the school eventually prosper. He was soon accepting Australian candidates for the brothers into the St Patrick's community and acted as their novice master. In 1875 he investigated the purchase of land at Hunters Hill for a boarding school and novitiate, and was novice master there from 1878 onwards.

In 1884 he was appointed to work in New Caledonia, and the following year returned to Europe. He died in France in 1924.

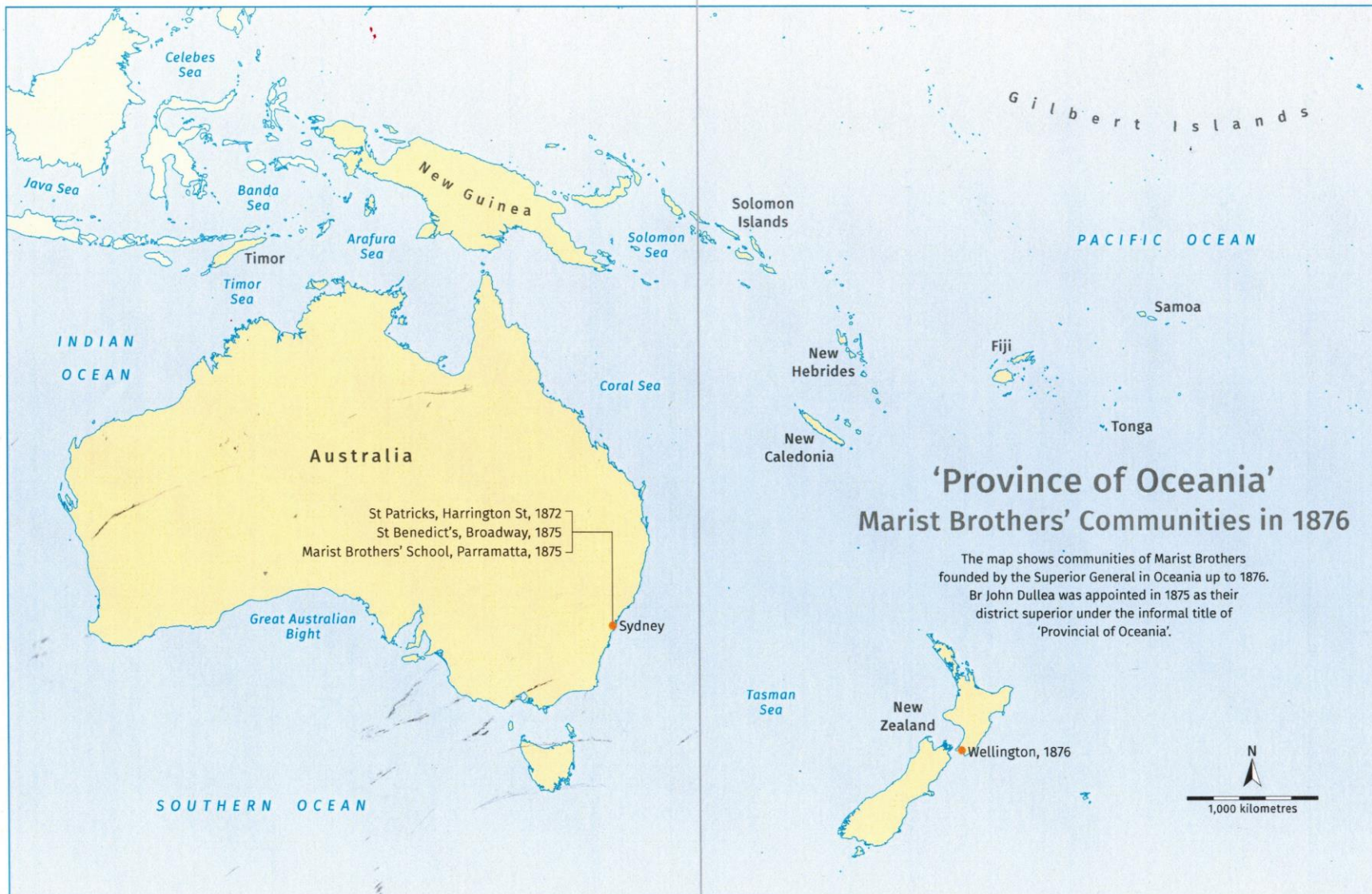

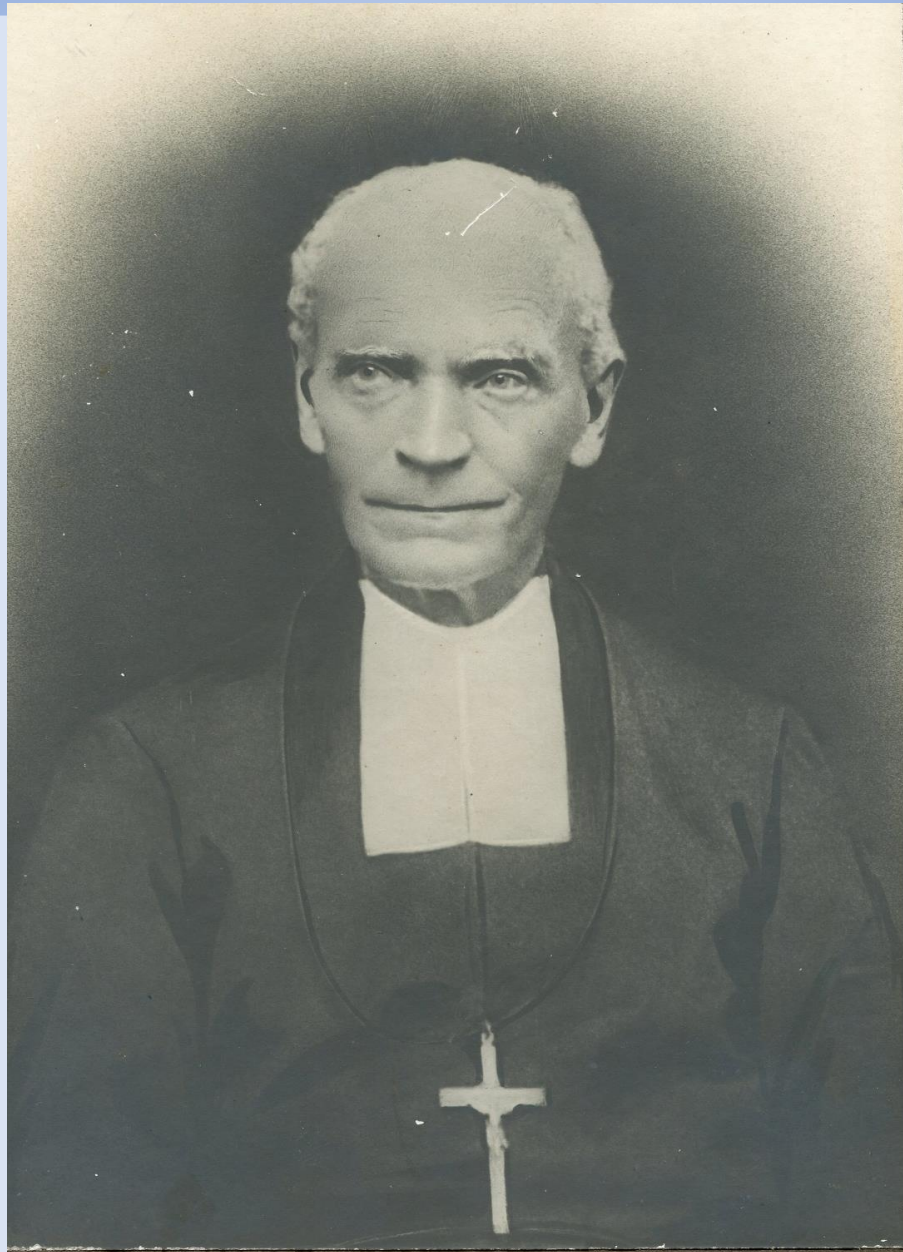

Early St Patrick's School in Harrington Street Sydney. The school is the building with the arched windows



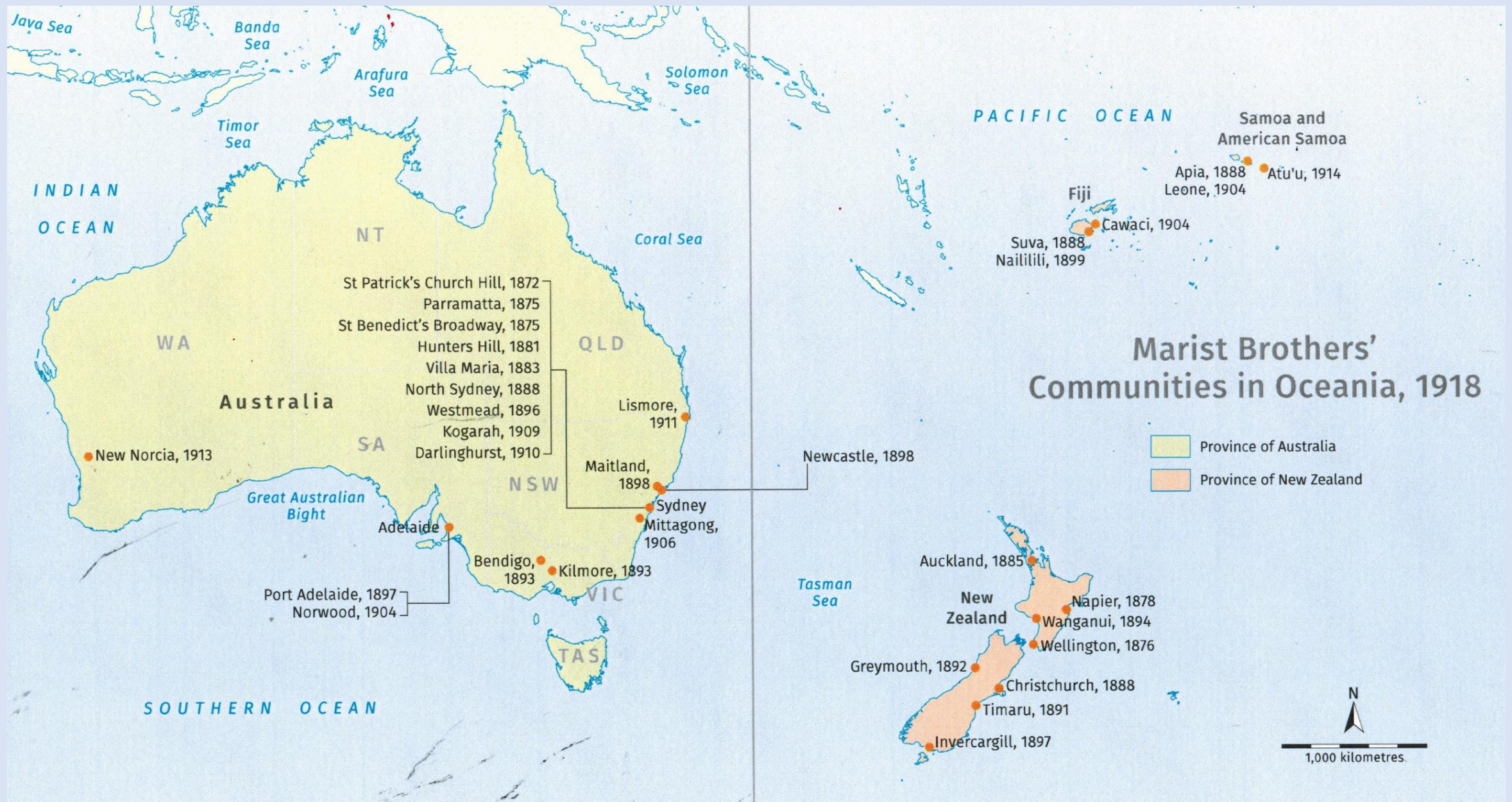

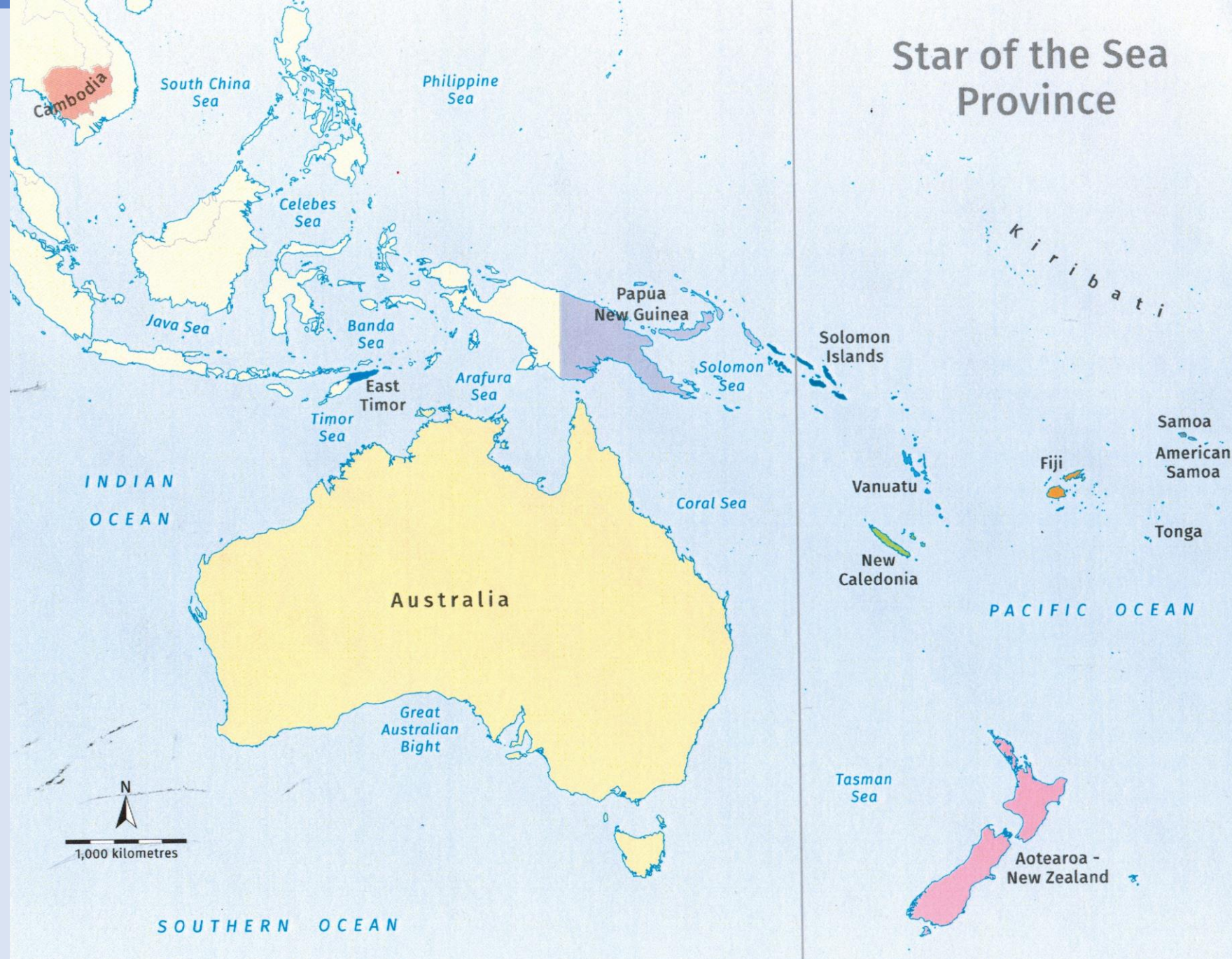
